Parade Details

Competitive band, non-competitive band, and Color Guard participate in parades. Parents are encouraged to watch and cheer along the parade route.

What to Wear - Travel/Casual Uniforms


All Marching Band and Color Guard are to wear their:

- · Westview GOLD Polo
- Khaki shorts
- Short socks and Dinkles, Vanguard/ Drillmaster marching shoes
- Black socks/shoes (All Marching Band)
- White socks/shoes (Color Guard)

If a student still does not have a travel/casual uniform by the day of the parade, please wear a plain black polo shirt with a collar and khaki/tan/beige shorts. **DO NOT** substitute other Westview T-Shirts for the polo shirt. Black polo shirts with a collar will blend in much more than T-Shirts.

Please note the following:

- Students meet in the parking lot on Pomerado & Poway Road no later than 8AM.
- Students will need to provide their own transportation.
- DRIVERS PLEASE DO NOT PULL INTO THE POMERADO PARKING LOT FOR STUDENT DROP-OFF for STUDENT SAFETY!!
- The Poway Days Parade starts at 9AM. The estimated end time is 10:30AM.
- Students are dismissed once the parade has been completed.
- NEW for 2018: The Parade will end at Bowron Road at Poway Road.
- The Westview GOLD Band will exit to an available area please look for your student who will be with our group.
- IMPORTANT: Be sure to check the Westview GOLD Calendar and/or Westview GOLD Facebook
 pages on the morning of the parade for any last minute changes to the above information.

GOLD is Getting a Semi-Trailer!

What you can do to help make it ready for GOLD Program use!

A used 53' semi-trailer has been graciously donated to the Westview GOLD program by Corodata and the Hall family, but it needs some work to convert it for Marching Band usage. To make this trailer ready for the upcoming season we are looking for help from current GOLD parents, parents of alumni, alumni, and anyone else who supports music and the arts. You are especially invited to be a part of a lasting symbol of the GOLD program that will be proudly on display at tournaments and major events.

Specifically, we are looking for people with expertise, time and/or materials towards outfitting the trailer with:

- Exterior painting (gloss black)
- · Exterior vinyl graphics and lettering, or painted lettering
- 12V LED lighting
- Electrical systems (wiring, switchgear, deep cycle batteries, 12V solar panels
- Metal fabrication and welding
- · Wood or composite decking and shelving
- Trailer door hardware and lighting
- Hardware, latch or tiedown equipment
- · Loading ramps, folding and/or hydraulically deployed

Advertising on a section of the trailer may be an option in return for the conversions.

We also need a truck driver with a tractor to tow the trailer to ~5 - 7 tournaments per season (October - November).

Stay tuned for announcements for work parties to prepare the trailer.
